Basic Skills Education

To enroll in basic skills, all students must pay a \$25 fee per quarter.

Adult Basic Education (ABE) classes provide instruction in basic reading, writing, mathematics, social studies, and science in preparation for enrolling in college or entering the workplace. General Education Diploma (GED) Preparation classes provide individual instructions in reading, writing, mathematics, social studies, and science based on diagnostic testing. Students only work in areas which they need assistance. A combination of online and 'face to face' instruction may be available for GED students. Students may enroll any time during the quarter. Integrated Basic Education and Skills Training (I-BEST): I-BEST classes combine technical classes with basic skills and/or English as a Second Language classes so that student can gain vocational skills at the same time.
